Structural basis for the heptameric activity of P65, a transmembrane nucleoprotein of the Epstein-Barr virus. The nucleocapsid protein P65 of Epstein-Barr virus (EBV) is essential for the packaging of viral genome into the viral capsid and thus for viral replication. It is a membrane protein with three transmembrane domains and with six cytoplasmic helices. Electron microscopy studies have previously shown that P65 is hexameric and that, as a nucleoprotein, it forms 60-70nm hexamers. Here we report that P65 is also a heptamer and that it assembles into rings at least up to a size of 14nm. The P65 protein from a Chinese EBV isolate is slightly larger than its Dutch counterpart, and this difference is important because the Chinese isolate is biologically more active than the Dutch isolate. Structural analysis of both proteins was carried out by negative stain electron microscopy. Size-exclusion chromatography of both P65 proteins indicates that they are dimers in solution. Stable dimers show a 2:2 orientation, whereas no stable dimers could be detected for the larger particles. The 2:2 orientation is confirmed by surface plasmon resonance, showing a positive cooperativity and a dissociation constant of 0.7microM. By homology modelling we have created a P65 monomer that fits the EM data, suggesting that the hexameric structure of the P65 is formed by two 2:2 dimers.
